

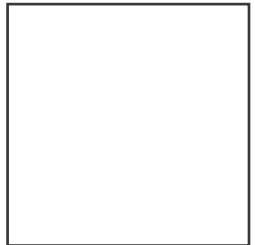

Members: \$275
Non-Members: \$300
- Camper must be pre-registered for before/after care.
\$15 per session of care
- Late Registration Fee: Starting the Thursday prior to the desired week of camp. **Additional \$25**

- All Children must have completed a Pre-K or an equivalent program prior to attending CCMSH Summer Camp.
- Camp begins at 9:00 am and concludes at 4:00 pm.
- Before and after care are available for an additional cost. Must pre-register for before and after care.
- Sessions are age appropriate with exciting activities.
- Each camper receives 1 complimentary t-shirt per session.
- All sessions include two field trips, one to Hurricane Alley and the other according to which week they will attend. Field trips are subject to change due to weather or cancellations.
- Scholarships are available but are limited.
